Dear LIRC Members and Guests:

The Louisville Indoor Racquet Club is gradually starting to open up!! We are adhering to the guidelines set up by the government officials and we appreciate your support. We have considered numerous factors in reopening and are keeping the safety of our members and staff as our top priority. We ask everyone to be vigilant and adhere to the social distancing policies for public gatherings. We are also asking that you maintain the 6' social distance guideline at all times. PLEASE DO NOT COME TO THE CLUB IF YOU ARE SICK.

We are reopening the club in stages:

Starting on Tuesday May 26th, we will have all outdoor courts open for doubles and singles play, plus pro lessons, both privates and clinics. There will be a staff working the phones for payments and drop off and pick up of racquets to be restrung, sale of balls and grips, from 10 am-6pm, but the main building will still be closed May 26- May 31st. There will be no bathrooms, no water, no chairs, no towels available on the outside tennis courts.

Starting on Monday June 1st, the whole club will be open inside and outside. We have several leagues and practices starting this first week, so we will have all doors open so that people don't have to congregate in the lobby. If you are getting direct billed, please go right to your assigned courts. The pro shop will be open for shopping but all sales will be final sale at this time. The bathrooms will be open but the showers will still be closed. There still will be no water on court, no chairs, no towels, no babysitting, no loaner racquets, no demo racquets, and no hanging out in the lobby. All league schedules will be emailed to your league coordinators so that you can have the schedule on your phone. We would really appreciate it if you would only enter the building right before you have to go onto the court. At this time the pros are offering clinics and privates but no Fast Feeds at this time.

Players should start bringing their own hand sanitizer, their own water, and their own chair (if they wish). We will no longer have a lost and found. Everything that is left will be thrown away every day.

Please be aware of many other signs and protocols around the Club in a continuing effort to keep everyone safe and enjoying the facility. Also please be respectful of others and maintain social distancing. We thank everyone for the continued support and enduring some of these inconveniences until we get through this challenging time.
